The purpose of the interview is to confirm that the work you have submitted is your own and that you did not have any assistance in completing your NEBOSH assessment. • IG2 - The practical assessment of the NEBOSH General Certificate. It tests your ability to apply your learning in the real world. You're required to produce a risk assessment of your workplace that identifies a range of hazards. The risk assessment must be suitable and sufficient.
