<b>Course Overview:</b>	This 0.5-day is to refresh food handlers on the knowledge and application skills to Follow Food & Beverage Safety and Hygiene Policies and Procedures.
<b>Who Should Attend</b>	<p>Food handlers will now be required to attend their first refresher training five years after completing their Basic Food Hygiene Course and the subsequent ones at 10-year intervals, instead of the previous cycle of once every three years.</p> <p>If you have completed your Basic Food Hygiene Course before 1 Oct 2014, you are required to attend your first refresher training 3 years after your course completion date instead of 5 years.</p>
<b>Course Objectives:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Practise good personal hygiene</li> <li>2. Use safe ingredients</li> <li>3. Handle food safely</li> <li>4. Store food safely</li> <li>5. Maintain cleanliness of utensils, equipment and service/storage areas</li> </ol>
<b>Course Duration:</b>	4.5 hours (incl. of 1.5 hours of assessment)
<b>Course Fees:</b>	\$100
<b>Mode of Instruction:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lecture</li> <li>• Discussion</li> <li>• Demonstration / Practice</li> <li>• Role Play</li> <li>• Observation / Feedback</li> </ul>
<b>Mode of Delivery:</b>	Full-time
<b>Mode of Assessment:</b>	At the end of the module, learners are required to complete a total of 1 hour and 30 minutes of assessment, comprising a written assessment, role plays and oral questioning. <b>Depending on the speed each learner takes to complete the assessment, the assessment will end later than the stipulated time.</b>
<b>Attendance Requirement:</b>	A 75% minimum attendance is required for learner to be eligible to complete a WSQ Qualification
<b>Passing Criteria:</b>	Learners must be deemed 'C' Competent in all the assessment components to pass.
<b>Qualification:</b>	Upon successful completion of course and assessment, learners will be awarded a Statement of Attainment (SOA) issued by the SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG) and Singapore Food Agency (SFA).
<b>Entry Qualification:</b>	Learners are expected to demonstrate competency at Level 4 (i.e. lower secondary) for Employability Skills WSQ Work Place Literacy and Numeracy (WPLN).
<b>Average Teacher to Student Ratio:</b>	1:20
