Course Overview:	This 3-day module takes you through the process of identifying the different types of F&B concepts and their intrinsic operational characteristics via the development of comprehensive matrix charts. It explores the process of analysing and understanding the reasons for the success of various restaurant concepts with specific target markets. After the selection and development of a particular F&B concept, you will learn how to engineer sales-maximising menus and select profitable outlet locations that fits your concept like a glove.
Who Should Attend:	Operation Managers, Multi-Outlet Managers, Outlet Managers and Assistant Outlet Managers in F&B service. Their responsibilities often involve formulating, executing and reviewing sales plan system of their respective establishments. However, they have no formal training in this area.
